At Churchill Pavilion you will learn a range of skills like making bird boxes, butterfly boxes or an item which may help encourage wildlife, you will work with a local nature reserve and warden to establish where these projects will be best suited. You will also learn to:

- Work together as a group and make group decisions
- Follow instructions
- Using Safe Working Practices and using the hand tools and cordless drill safely
- Select materials
- Minimise wastage
