## Maths (Entry 1 / Entry 2)

This course allows you to brush up on your skills in Maths. <b>You must attend for an assessment before you start the course.</b> These courses are free.	

<b>What will I learn on this course?</b>
You will be invited along to an initial assessment to find out what you need to work on and agree your learning aims. For example, you may need to: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Read and write numbers</li><li>• Add and subtract</li><li>• Recognise selected coins and notes</li><li>• Work with basic measurement and shape.</li></ul>

<b>Assessment</b>	<b>Awarding Body: City and Guilds</b>
The aim of this course is to improve your basic Maths skills. They are assessed using assignment tasks.	

<b>Course Length</b>
You may need just a few weeks of practice or up to 72 hours of tuition – it's all free.

<b>Attendance</b>
In order that you will be able to successfully complete your qualification it is essential that you attend 90% of the taught sessions, so please think carefully before enrolling on this course if you have work or other commitments that may interfere with your attendance.

<b>What else do I need to know?</b>
You can begin at any point in the year, and you will work towards the following qualifications: Maths Level 1 or 2 – laying the groundwork and brushing up on the basics.

<b>What could I do next?</b>
You could move up to the next Level in Maths or onto an English course.
